

Golf Day at Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course (South/East course)



The Golf Interest Group (GIG) has organised a golf day at Kau Sai Chau where members can choose to play on either the South Course, more player friendly for beginners or high-handicappers; or the East Course, more challenging for experienced players. There will be 3 flights on each course. This will enable different levels of players to join the event.

Date: Friday, 24 May 2013

Time: First tee off time at 8:24 am at both South Course and East Course

Venue: Jockey Club Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course (KSC), Sai Kung

Min. Handicap: Men at 36.4 and Ladies at 40.4

Participants are required to indicate whether they have the KSC Golf Pass Certificate, or latest official handicap index (issued by HK Golf Association or other recognized golf associations/clubs). KSC requires that for **South Course** at least **one** player per flight with the required handicap level, and for **East Course** at least **two** players per flight with the required handicap level.

*KSC requires an extra \$100/player for group booking below 16 players. The \$100 can be used on any purchase at the golf shop or restaurant at KSC within 12 months. However, if the total enrolment exceeds 16 players, KSC will NOT charge the extra \$100 and we will refund the same to members.

<u>Payment by cheque:</u> Please write out <u>two cheques</u> for the enrolment. One cheque for the green fee and the other cheque for the extra \$100. Should the total number of players exceed 16, we will return your \$100 cheque by mail after the deadline for enrolment.

Payment by credit card: Only the payment for the green fee will be processed upon enrolment. The additional \$100 will be processed only after the close of deadline, if applicable.

Flight leaders: Experienced golfers are invited to be flight leaders.

Lunch: Lunch at KSC is optional at member's cost.

Car pool: Subject to demand and volunteering service by players.

Remarks

- The event will be cancelled if there are less than 8 players; or the requisite handicap requirement is not met.
- With complimentary use of electric golf cart on a sharing basis (not allowed on fairways or areas with turf).
- No caddy service is provided.
- Ferry service departing from Sai Kung at 20-minute interval, on the clock, 20-min past and 40-min past.
- Assembly at the South/East Course Reception Counter on G/F, Administration Building. Exact time to be advised.
 Players are required to bring their own golf gear (clubs, gloves, balls, tees, etc), and wear proper golf shoes and attire.
- Complimentary use of locker/changing room facilities available.
- KSC policy does NOT offer refund for late cancellation and/or no-show after confirmation.
