



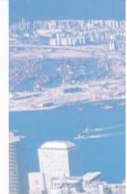
Photography Sharing Sessions

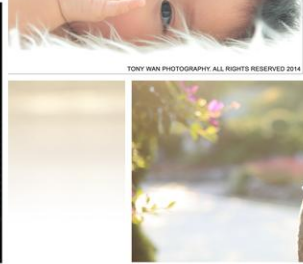
