With the latest regional growth moderation, slowing global trade and tightening global financial conditions, 2016 and upcoming year are set to be challenging to all. In a recent survey Coface conducted to examine corporate payment trends in 8 selected markets across the Asia-Pacific region; Australia, Mainland China, Hong Kong, India, Japan, Singapore, Taiwan and Thailand, 70% of the companies surveyed experienced overdues in 2015 with no improvement compared to 2014.
