#### About the seminar

Section 221 of the Companies Ordinance (the so-called 'Star Chamber clause') allows a liquidator to apply for the examination of persons, including former directors, to assist in the recovery of property or to provide him with information. It has been suggested academically that an order for examination under this section cannot be made against a person out of Hong Kong, and that the retreat from this position in the United Kingdom may not be followed in Hong Kong.

Last year, this suggestion was rejected by the Companies Judge and her decision has recently been upheld by the Court of Appeal. Mr. Roger Beresford will review the principles and the implications for directors who attempt to avoid these procedures by retreating or staying abroad.

#### About the speaker

Mr. Roger Beresford is a barrister of Prince's Chambers. He was called to the bar in 1994 in the UK and in 1999 in HK.
