

RECRUITMENT OF TUTORS AND WORKSHOP FACILITATORS FOR SQ (TAXATION) PROGRAMME

The Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants invites applications for Tutors and Workshop Facilitators for its upcoming offering of the SQ (Taxation) programme, which will commence in April 2012. Interested parties with adequate knowledge and experience can choose to apply for **ONE or BOTH** roles. This is a nine-month, part-time Programme, with tutorials to be held on weekday evenings and workshops on Saturday mornings.

Objective of the Programme

The programme will provide candidates with an in-depth and integrated study of the different aspects in taxation. It will enable candidates to enhance their competence in the field of Hong Kong taxation and to broaden their competence in the fields of China and international taxation.

Programme Coverage

The entire Programme consists of the following modules:

- Advanced Hong Kong Tax
- China Tax
- International Tax

Programme Structure

- 17 Tutorials, each of 2 hours' duration
- 16 Workshops, each of 3 hours' duration

Who is the SQ (Taxation) designed for?

SQ (Taxation) students are typically tax professionals who want to move their careers to the next critical stage. They will share a desire to extend their tax knowledge and practical experience and stretch themselves as high-calibre managers to become sophisticated tax advisers in an increasingly complex environment.

While the class is primarily for CPAs, one of its valuable features is sharing experience in tutorials with fellow professionals from different backgrounds and with different skill sets. Spaces are therefore reserved on the programme for non CPAs working in taxation, to encourage a broad and diversified participation. Applicants who are not members of the Institute but who wish to move into the field of taxation may be accepted onto the course at the discretion of the Institute, subject to the availability of places.

Medium of Instruction

English

Assessment

Assessment will include in-class presentation (10%) and 3 open book examinations (90%).

Remuneration

Tutors: HK\$2,100 per tutorial session of 2 hours each for each tutor.

<u>Workshop Facilitators</u>: HK\$2,520 per workshop of 3 hours each for each Workshop Facilitator. TWO facilitators will be appointed for each workshop.

No extra remuneration will be paid for attending meetings and preparatory work before each tutorial.

Desirable Attributes

- Should possess in-depth knowledge with a minimum of 8 years solid experience as specialists in the area of taxation (Hong Kong, China and/or international).
- Senior Manager grade or above.
- Good presentation and training skills in English.
- Willing to share experiences and adopt an interactive approach in teaching.
- Have a passion about the development and practice of taxation law and practice.
- Be enthusiastic about nurturing a new generation of taxation practitioners for the betterment of the profession.

Tutorial Sessions and Tutors' role

- Tutorial sessions of 2 hours each are to be held on **weekday evenings**. There are 15 teaching tutorial sessions and 2 additional tutorials for the assessed in-class presentations. Please refer to the timetable for details.
- One tutor will be appointed to lead a tutorial group of about 12 students.
- The same tutor is expected to lead the same tutorial group throughout one whole module. An individual may apply to be a tutor for more than one module.
- Tutorial materials such as discussion questions and case studies are provided. Tutors are required to lead the tutorial sessions based on the tutorial materials provided.
- Tutors are responsible for assessing students' in-class presentations using a marking scheme provided.
- Tutors are required to attend administration meetings with the Course Directors.

Workshops & Workshop Facilitators' role

- Workshops of 3 hours each on specific topics are to be held on **Saturday mornings**.
- Workshops include introductory presentations and interactive classroom discussions.
- Two Workshop Facilitators will be appointed for each Workshop.
- Topic outlines for the Workshops have been decided by the Institute. Please refer to the timetable for details.
- Presentation materials are provided and Workshop Facilitators are required to add supplementary materials based on their own experience.
- Workshop Facilitators are required to attend administration meetings with the Course Directors to ascertain the subject coverage of each Workshop.

CPD Hours

All preparatory and teaching hours will qualify as verifiable CPD hours.
