

Snooker Training Courses



Snooker is a billiards sport that requires skills to use a cue ball to pot the red balls and colored balls into the pockets. The popularity has been increasing among members since the first snooker activity held in 2011. To meet members' demand, new training courses for different levels of players have been scheduled as follows:

1A	Beginner	6 July to 24 August	2:00 – 4:00 pm
1B	Intermediate	(6 & 27 Jul and 3, 10, 17 & 24 Aug) [All Saturdays]	4:00 – 6:00 pm

Class size: Min 20 persons for each course (max 24)

Unless the minimum number of participants is reached, otherwise the course will

be cancelled.
