

The 12th Recreation and Sports Club for Hong Kong Professional Bodies Golf Tournament 2016

The 12th RSCP Golf Tournament will be held on **Wednesday**, **24 February 2016** at the Jockey Club Kau Sai Chau Public Golf Course, Sai Kung. Other participating professions include architects, dentists, doctors, solicitors and surveyors.

The Institute is recruiting 22 members to form its representative team. Members, whose golf handicap is 24 or below, are welcome to put forward their names for consideration. In the event that there are more than 22 members expressing their interest, an internal selection will be held based on members' handicap and past competition records, among other things.

To enable the selected teammates to meet up and get to know each other before the tournament, a pre-tournament lunch is tentatively scheduled on <u>Thursday</u>, 18 February at the Institute, 37/F Wu Chung House, 213 Queen's Road East.

Tee-off time : Starting at around 11:45 am (for both courses)

Registration Fee : \$1,000 for each player (inclusive of green fee, golf cart on South Course, ferry, dinner

and drinks)

Additional Fee for : - Caddy at \$300*

North Course players - Electric golf trolley at \$65*

(*Subject to availability and the fee is to be settled by participant on event day.)

Maximum handicap: 24

Maximum players : North Course - 8 players (with lowest handicap); South Course - 14 players

Format : Individual Stableford off New New Peoria Handicap (NNP)

Prizes : - The perpetual trophy will be awarded to the Champion team and medals to team

members of the champion, 1st and 2nd runner-up.

Trophies will be awarded to the Best Gross Score in North Course and South

Course.

- Trophies will be awarded to the Highest Stableford Point, North and South

Course jointly.

- Trophies will be awarded to each winner who has won the Nearest to Pin and Longest Drive in North and South Course. For Nearest to the Pin, only one

award can be won by any one player.

- There will be separate prizes for women for the Longest Drive in South and North

Courses when there are 3 or more female players.
