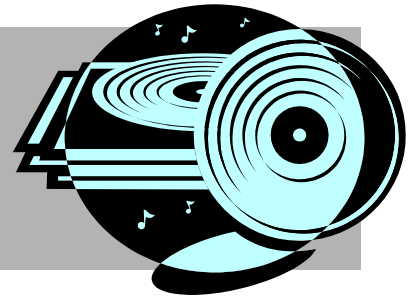




Studio Vocal Recording Classes

1. 基本歌唱技巧 - 拍子、音準、節奏、呼吸運用、吐字技巧、層次及歌曲演繹。
2. 錄音室歌唱技巧 - 錄音期間呼吸運用、衣著選擇。
3. 咪高峰運用技巧 - 錄音室專用之電容式咪高峰 (Condenser Microphone) 運用秘訣。
4. 模擬錄音體驗 - 會於正式錄音前之最後課堂進行。
5. 正式錄音 - 每位學員分別享有半小時錄音體驗，錄製個人單曲一首。

課程特色

- 適合已有基本歌唱認識人士。
- 完成錄音後，會擁有個人單曲 CD 一隻（已包括基本 CD 設計）錄音曲目長度不可多於 5 分鐘。

1. Priority of enrolment will be first offered to SgIG members and then to non-SgIG HKICPA members in the case of over-subscription. Non-members' applications will only be processed after registration deadline, subject to availability. We only accept non-members' enrolment as a guest of a member.
2. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
3. The closing date for enrolment is **2 January 2015**. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late enrolment as it sees fit.
