

# PAIB Seminar on COSO's Updated Internal Control – Integrated Framework

## **About the topic**

COSO, the Committee of Sponsoring Organizations of the Treadway Commission, issued an updated version of its widely-used internal control framework on 14 May 2013. The update guidance, *Internal Control – Integrated Framework* is expected to help organizations design and implement a system of internal control, given the many changes in business and operating environments since the original framework was issued in 1992. It also aims to broaden the application of internal control in addressing operations and reporting objectives and clarify the requirements for determining what constitutes effective internal control.

At this seminar, the speaker, Megan Haas, partner of PwC, will explore some of the key changes in the updated framework and the practical implications of these changes for businesses.
