Prior to his current job, Jun was the Chief Executive of Mizuho Securities in Hong Kong from 1999 to 2003. He has been engaging in the investment management and corporate finance business for more than 20 years.

June holds a degree in Bachelor of Economics from Keio University, and an MBA from University of Chicago.
