# Corporate finance discussion forum – Proposals to enhance the regulatory regime of sponsors

# **About the topic**

Sponsors play a key role as gatekeepers of market quality and are expected to conduct sufficient and reasonable due diligence to properly fulfil this role. In May 2012, the Securities and Futures Commission ("SFC") launched a <u>consultation</u> on proposals to enhance the regulatory regime of sponsors. The key elements of the proposals include:

- > Complete the vast majority of due diligence when submitting a listing application;
- Demonstrate that it is reasonable for a sponsor to rely on accountants' and valuers' work;
- > Post the first draft of the prospectus on the HKEx website;
- > Restrict the number of independent sponsors for each listing to one only or a limited number;
- > Make clear that sponsors have civil and criminal liability for untrue statements in a prospectus under the Companies Ordinance.

The Institute's corporate finance committee ("CFC") is currently studying the consultation paper.

At the forum, the SFC will explain issues concerning sponsors, reasons for the proposals and the key proposed requirements. Members are encouraged to take this opportunity to raise questions and exchange views with the regulator face-to-face.
