



RMB / HKD Dual Currency Equity Issuance: Hopewell Highway Infrastructure – first dual counter equity security traded on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited

About the topic

Main board-listed Hopewell Highway Infrastructure Limited offered the first renminbi (RMB)-traded equity security outside Mainland China and the first dual counter equity security traded on the Stock Exchange of Hong Kong, in addition to its Hong Kong dollar (HKD)-traded shares.

- overview and update on the RMB ecosystem in Hong Kong/ HKEx
