



Mainland companies converting B-shares into H-shares to list in Hong Kong

About the topic

As a result of the relaxation of the rules and regulations on the listing of PRC incorporated enterprises outside mainland China, and simplification of certain application process and approval procedures, more PRC incorporated enterprises are expected to be listed in Hong Kong. In particular, it is believed that a number of mainland B-share companies are considering a listing in the Hong Kong market. China International Marine Containers (Group) Ltd. ("CIMC") was the first mainland company to convert all its B-shares into H-shares and list on the main board of the Hong Kong Stock Exchange.

At this seminar, the speakers will discuss this new development with reference to the CIMC experience. Topics covered will include:

- An update on the recent changes on the requirements and processes in respect of the listing of PRC incorporated enterprises in Hong Kong and overseas
- The reasons for/benefits of conversion of B-shares into H-shares to list in Hong Kong
- Preparation for conversion of B-shares into H-shares and the challenges, including major technical considerations
- Market receptiveness of this conversion listing
- Trend for the conversion listing by the existing B-share mainland companies
