At the seminar, in addition to the recent <u>consultation on reporting and related record keeping rules</u> on OTC derivative transactions, Ms. Daphne Doo will also cover the following issues:

- ♦ G20 commitments on reforming the OTC market
- ♦ Securities and Futures (Amendment) Ordinance 2014
- Mandatory reporting, clearing and trading
- New and expanded regulatory activities
- ♦ Risk mitigation measures (margin and non-margin)
- ♦ Trade repositories, central counterparties for clearing and electronic trading platforms
- ♦ Cross-border issues
