ABOUT THE SEMINAR

The procurement of construction work is complex, and a successful outcome can be elusive. It is remarkably different from purchasing almost any other commodity associated with commercial activity. Construction contracts often use complex standard forms of contract which are adapted extensively and are comprised of a large volume and variety of documents.

The talk will discuss:

- the principal functions of a construction contract;
- the types of construction contract commonly used in Hong Kong;
- the documents which form a construction contract;
- · the key characteristics of construction contracts; and
- the principal risks associated with construction contracts.
