

Applications in respect of mentally-incapacitated persons – a growing area of business for appointment takers

About the topic

According to a study conducted by the Department of Health and the Chinese University of Hong Kong, nearly one in ten Hong Kong residents aged 70 and above suffer from dementia. With people living longer in Hong Kong, the number of dementia sufferers who require assistance in relation to their financial affairs is set to grow.

At this seminar, John Budge of Wilkinson & Grist will talk about applications in respect of mentally-incapacitated persons under the Mental Health Ordinance (Cap. 136), a growing area of importance in Hong Kong, with over 70,000 people suffering from dementia. He will discuss how to apply for Guardianship and Committeeship Orders and the approach adopted by the Guardianship Board and the High Court. He will also discuss effective estate planning, including entering into an Enduring Power of Attorney.
