



## Legislative Proposals to Improve Hong Kong's Corporate Insolvency and Winding-up Regime

### About the topic

On 16 April, the government launched a three-month public consultation on 46 legislative proposals to improve the corporate insolvency and winding-up provisions of the Companies Ordinance. The consultation document can be downloaded from [http://www.fstb.gov.hk/fsb/ppr/consult/doc/impcill\\_consult\\_e.pdf](http://www.fstb.gov.hk/fsb/ppr/consult/doc/impcill_consult_e.pdf). The proposals cover the following five aspects of the winding-up process, namely:

1. the commencement of winding-up;
2. the appointment, powers, vacation of office and release of provisional liquidators and liquidators;
3. the conduct of the winding-up process;
4. voidable transactions; and
5. the investigation during winding-up, offences antecedent to or in the course of winding-up and powers of the court.

At this seminar, the speakers will focus on the issues that are specifically highlighted for consultation.
