



Determining Limitation Periods for Recovery Actions

About the topic

Missing a limitation period for a recovery action could mean negligence on the part of the liquidator concerned and could result in a claim against the liquidator. However, the exact limitation period for a particular recovery action is often not easy to determine. A lot depends on the nature of action, how it is framed, who takes the action and a myriad of other factors. Great care is also needed to ascertain when the cause of action is deemed to have accrued and the effects of fraud and concealment on the calculation of limitation periods.

In this seminar, Ludwig Ng of ONC Lawyers will take us through the maze of legislative provisions and case law and explain the legal concepts for determining the limitation periods applicable to various types of recovery actions.
