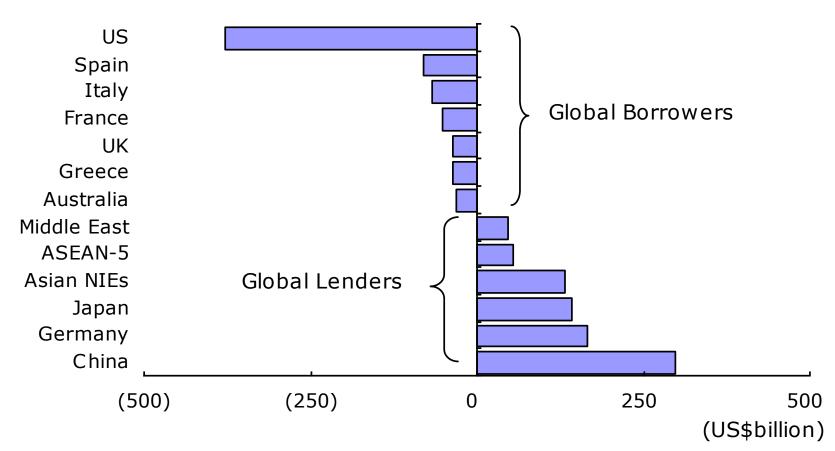

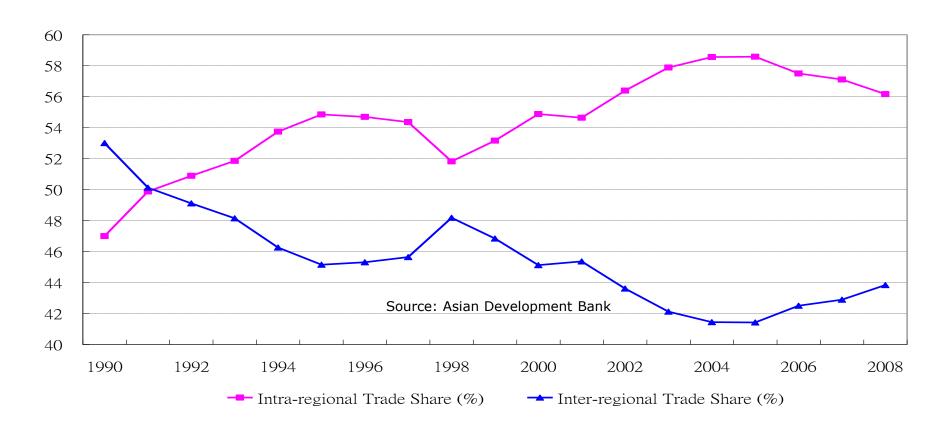

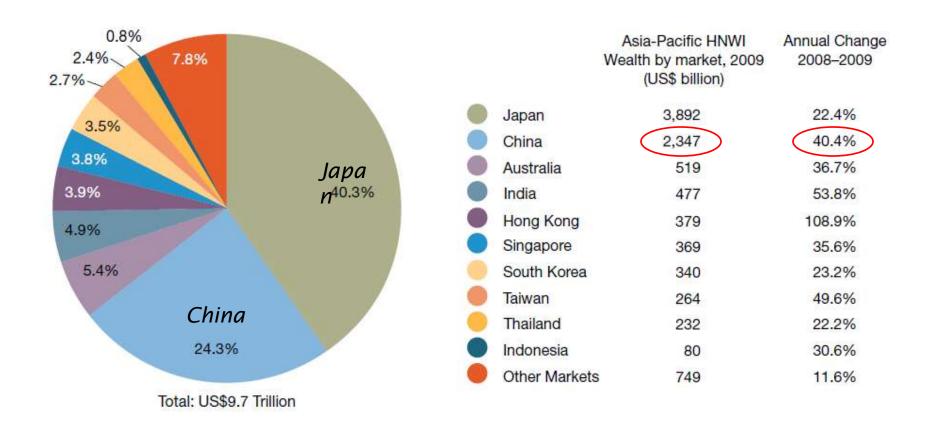

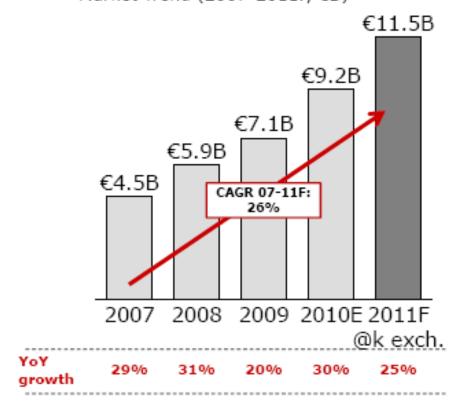

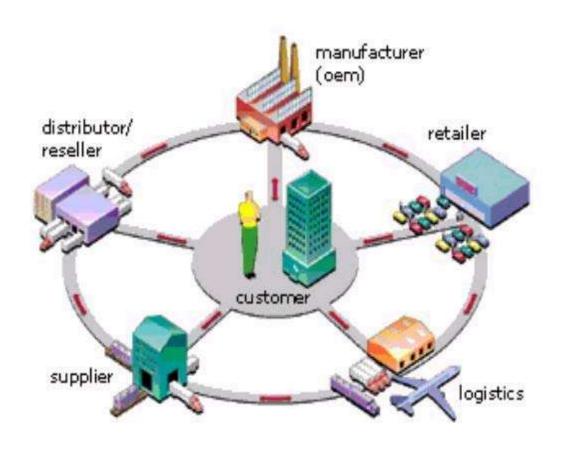

- Renowned exhibition hub of Asia

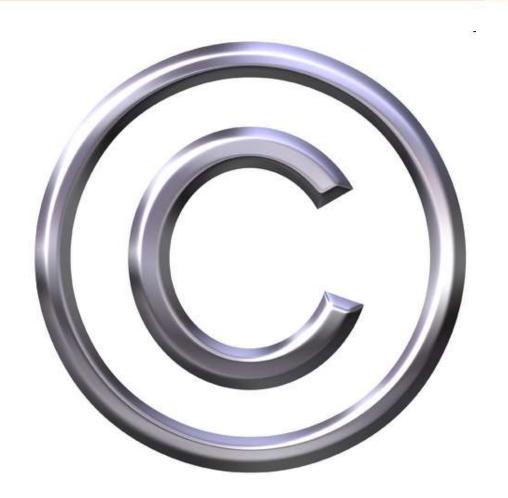

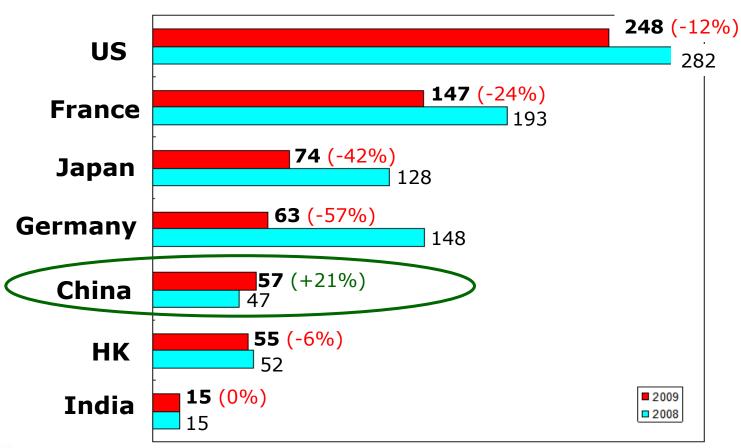

Outbound Direct Investment of selected countries and regions, 2009 Vs 2008 (USD bn)

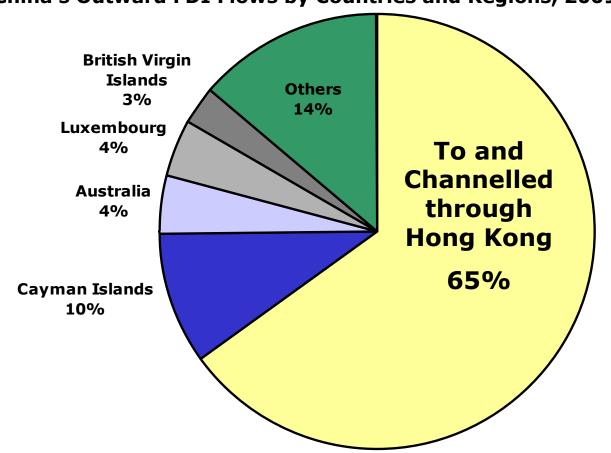
