Qualification Programme (QP) Special Arrangement for December 2024 Session

Eligibility

Final year students of designated local accountancy master/ conversion programmes accredited by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (the HKICPA) who:

- i. are in the **final semester of their final academic year**; and
- ii. can <u>complete the relevant courses in their accredited programmes after result release</u> of final semester; and
- iii. are able to confirm their graduation status by mid-August 2024.

Features

Under this special arrangement, participating students can <u>commence the QP in advance before</u> <u>official graduation</u> and <u>may be able to complete the QP at least six months earlier than those</u> <u>who do not join the special arrangement</u>. It will give them the flexibility in their study plans, and also enhance their technical knowledge and soft skills to pursue a career in the accounting profession.

Application and Deadline

Eligible applicants should submit the QP application at: <u>www.hkicpa.org.hk</u> \rightarrow Become a Hong Kong CPA \rightarrow QP \rightarrow <u>Application and registration</u>

The **application deadline is 15 May 2024 (Wed)**. Failure to submit the required documents (*please refer to P.2 - Important Dates*) by the deadline will delay the processing of the application.

Important Notes

- Applicants will be admitted to the QP <u>conditionally</u> subject to the attainment of their graduation status on the agreed cut-off date with the tertiary institutions.
- In the event that the applicants fail to confirm the graduation status by the agreed cut-off date, they will be removed from the QP Student Register immediately. Those applicants will need to re-register their QP studentship with the Institute after acquiring the graduation status in order to continue the remaining parts of the QP and payment of the required fees upon re-registration.
- After completion of QP registration process, QP students entitled the exemption of 8 or more QP Associate Modules can enrol for the Introductory Workshop together with any two* Professional modules after they accept the QP assessment result.

Introductory Workshop
Module 11 – Financial Reporting
Module 12 – Business Finance
Module 13 – Business Assurance
Module 14 – Taxation

*QP students are allowed to enrol in a maximum of two *first* attempt modules per exam session.





- If applicants do not complete all required courses under the approved curriculum for the accredited programme, they are not eligible for the exemption for particular module(s) in the Associate Level. Please refer to "Section 4 Self-assessment" in the QP application system for details.
- The module results attained will be valid for ten years from the date of initial registration as a QP student under the Professional Accountants By-Law 39.
